EVENT POLICIES

Video Policy: You may video your own dog for your own personal use. You may also video Jen's demos, feedback, lectures, and comments for your own personal use. However, you may not post these comments on any social media or other internet site. You may not forward or duplicate any comments on instruction to you. You may NOT video any other participant without their express permission (you must ask BEFORE videoing anyone else, including Jen working her own dog). Any violation of this policy is grounds for immediate dismissal from the workshop with no refund and will render you ineligible for attending any future workshops sponsored by Touch & Go Agility.

Payment Policy:

- Within 72 hours of you submitting a registration, an email will be sent to you telling you which workshops / seminars you have been registered for. This email will provide further payment information. Please do NOT send any funds until you receive that email.
- After you receive that information email, you have 7 days to cancel.
- If cancellation is not received within 7 days, you still owe full payment unless your spot can be filled

Refund Policy:

- If you have to withdraw and your spot is filled from a waitlist, you will receive a full refund
- There is no guarantee of a waitlist
- If there is no waitlist, there will be no refund. You can transfer your working spot to another, suitable team. It is the sole responsibility of the participant to find a substitute if there is not waitlist.
- In the event of cancellation due to natural disaster, severe weather, pandemic, illness, acts of God, or other events beyond the control of the event organizer – all monies will be refunded after any non-refundable seminar expenses are paid.

Bitches in Season: Are permitted, but must wear pants at all times.

Multiple dogs: You may work up to two dogs. Your second dog must be of equal or higher level than your primary dog. You may only work ONE dog per exercise.
